The Society's utmost priority is the safety of everyone involved in the 2023 Shrewsbury Flower Show. It therefore reserves the right to reasonably revise, remove or amend the content of this schedule, where necessary.

General Theme: **STAGE AND SCREEN**

Closing Date for Entries: Friday 21st July 2023

(The Society reserves the right to limit entries as necessary)

FLORAL ART SCHEDULE: All classes will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual (**Third edition 2015**) with the exception of **Class 307 & 316** which will be judged and marks allocated in accordance with the UK Floristry Judges Guild, Judges Marketing Facets (www.floristryjudgesguild.co.uk).

An EXHIBIT is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified in a show schedule.

NAFAS Rules state that disqualification will take place for the following reasons:

- Failure to comply with any specific requirements of a class as stated in a show schedule i.e. the measurements or the components.
- Inclusion of any fresh plant material that does not have its roots or the cut ends of its stems in water or water-retaining material. *For exclusion see the NAFAS Competitions Manual (Third Edition 2015)*
- Inclusion of artificial plant material, unless specifically allowed by a show schedule.

All exhibits, unless otherwise specified in the schedule, to be made up/staged in the marquee and must be the unaided work of each exhibitor.

For further details and definitions please refer to the NAFAS Competitions Manual (Third Edition 2015) in accordance with which classes will be judged which is available from NAFAS Headquarters, 1st Floor, 42-44 Bishopsgate, London EC2N 4AH.

Height of backcloth above tabling approximately 80cms, draped in Pale Green. EXHIBITS MAY EXCEED THIS IF DESIRED. Staging for all classes, unless otherwise specified, approximately 75cms above ground level. All measurements are approximate to cover any unavoidable irregularities.

Staging Times:

9.00am Thursday 10th August to 6.00am Friday 11th August.
Please note tea/coffee and biscuits will be provided.

Judging Times:

Judging will begin promptly at 6.30am Friday 11th August. The Marquee must be cleared of all exhibitors by 6.00am.

THE JUDGES' DECISION IS FINAL.

ALL CLASSES WILL BE JUDGED FROM THE FRONT UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.

The marquee will be cleared of people at 5.45pm on Saturday 12th August. No dismantling of exhibits may take place until exhibitors are re-admitted at 6pm. The marquee will be closed at 7.30pm by which time all exhibits must be removed or they will be disposed of by the Society.

There will be a separate bin for the disposal of non-biodegradable floral foam.

Members of the Shropshire Horticultural Society's General Committee may not exhibit in the competitive classes. All exhibitors must comply with the regulations of the Society as stated. Non-observance of them may result in withholding of awards.

Cancellation of Entries

Exhibitors unable or failing to stage their exhibit will **NOT** be refunded.

Exhibitors' Badge/Collection Permit/Vehicle Collection Permits

After exhibits have been staged a Steward will issue the relevant badge/collection permit/vehicle collection permit.

Badges must always be signed and worn during the show.

All Junior Exhibitors will be issued with an Exhibitors Badge.

Vehicles

Exhibitors' vehicles must be removed from the Showground before 7.00am on Friday 11th August. A 10 miles per hour speed limit will always be enforced around the Showground. Any remaining vehicles will be towed away at a cost of £100 to the exhibitor.

Only vehicles with the appropriate Collection Permit clearly displayed in their vehicle will be admitted after 6.45pm on Saturday at the Welsh Bridge Gate entrance and must exit via Priory Road Gate.

Please note: Only persons in vehicles with the correct badge/ticket will be allowed entry to the Showground.

Vehicle passes are issued at the discretion of the Society.

Any instruction issued by SLS Security **must** always be complied with.
